

YOUR INVITATION TO SAA MEMBERSHIP!

Except as noted below, all members have voting privileges, may serve on committees, have access to the online membership directory, receive *The SAA Archaeological Record*, and receive one journal (either *American Antiquity* or *Latin American Antiquity*)—plus discounts on publications and meeting registration.

REGULAR Annual dues \$130/\$60*

Any person who is engaged in archaeology or any related aspect thereof or any person who supports the objectives of the society.

STUDENT Annual dues: \$70/\$57*

Any person matriculating in an educational institution pursuing candidacy for a degree (Associate or higher) in a field of study related to some aspect of archaeology.

ASSOCIATE Annual dues \$54/\$43*

Any person who is not a professional archaeologist and who supports the objectives of the society. Non-voting member who does not receive a scholarly journal.

RETIRED Annual dues \$77/\$60*

Any person who has retired from remunerative professional life.

JOINT Annual dues \$43/\$32*

Any person who is the spouse or domestic partner of a Regular, Life, Retired, or Student member and who supports the objectives of the Society. Receives publications via member spouse or partner.

LIFE Dues: \$26,000*

Any person who supports the objectives of the society may become a Life member under conditions as determined by the Board of Directors.

Membership is based on the calendar year. Applications received before September 15 are fulfilled for the current year; applications received thereafter are treated as memberships for the next year.

*Dues amounts listed above are standard and discount rates respectively. Standard Rate applies to members living in Australia, Bahrain, Bermuda, Brunei, Canada, Cyprus, Israel, Japan, Korea, Kuwait, Libya, New Caledonia, New Zealand, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sultanate of Oman, Singapore, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates, United States, or Western Europe. Discount Rate applies to members living in Latin America or any other country not included above.
